Epoisses - French washed rind cheese



Epoisses is a famous French washed-rind cheese from the village of Epoisses found in the Côte-d'Or. The cheese is washed in marc de Bourgogne, the local pomace brandy which gives it a distinctive soft red-orange colour.

This cheese is very pungent (rumour has it's banned on all forms of public transport in France) and is not for the faint hearted, but those that love a good smelly flavoured cheese are in for a treat!

Napoleon was a particular fan of the cheese and the famous epicure Brillat-Savarin himself classed it as the "king of all cheeses". It is best served with a good red Burgundy wine, or even Sauternes.
